Her research focuses on health services research and implementation science in long-term care of older persons (both residential care and home care), with special interest in patient safety and quality of care, and the implementation of new models of care to improve the care of older persons. She has been a scientific advisor for the development and implementation of national quality indicators in Swiss long-term care and is responsible for two academic-service-partnerships with nursing homes in Basel and Zurich, maintaining the link to the practice field of care.
