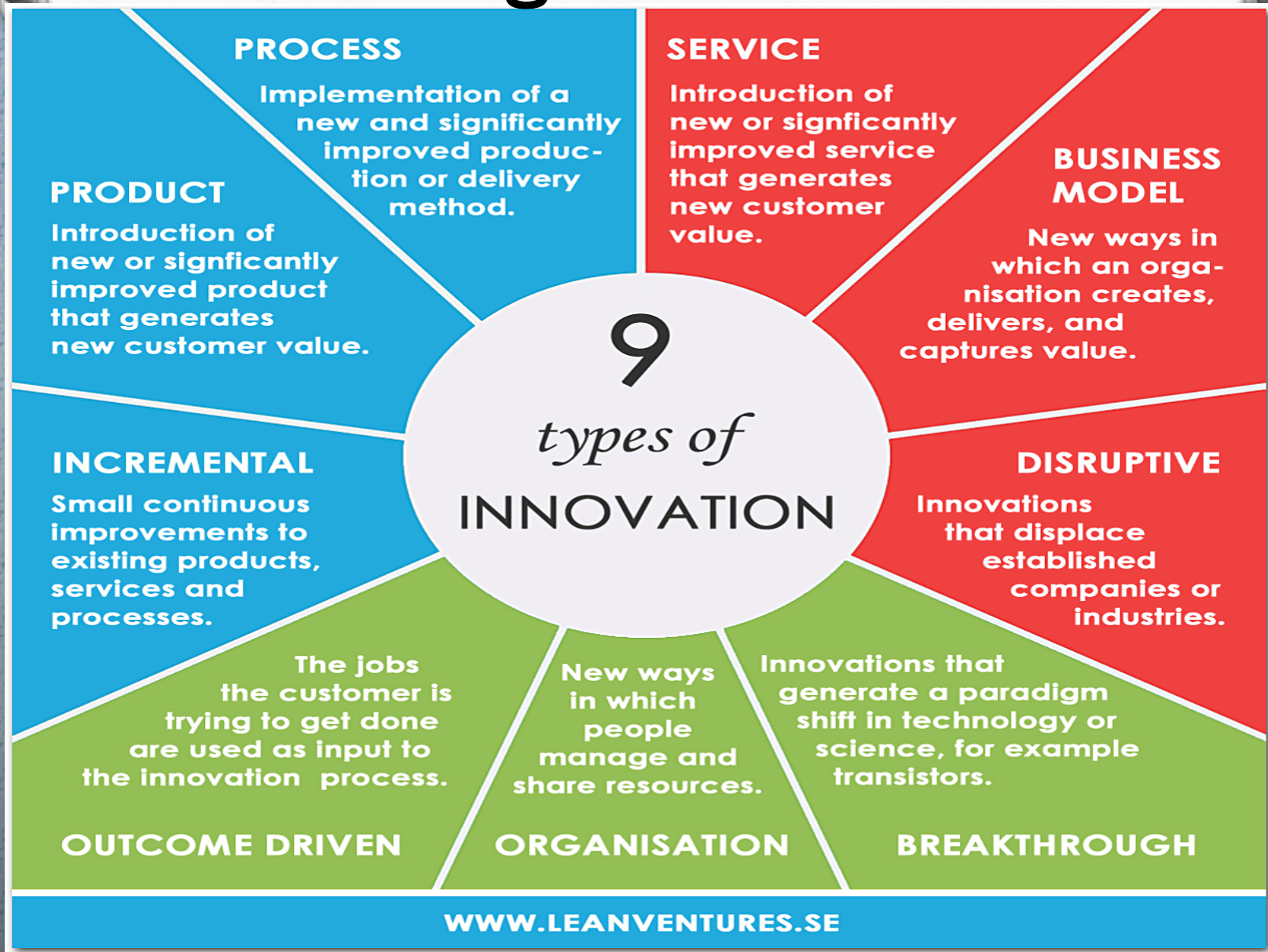

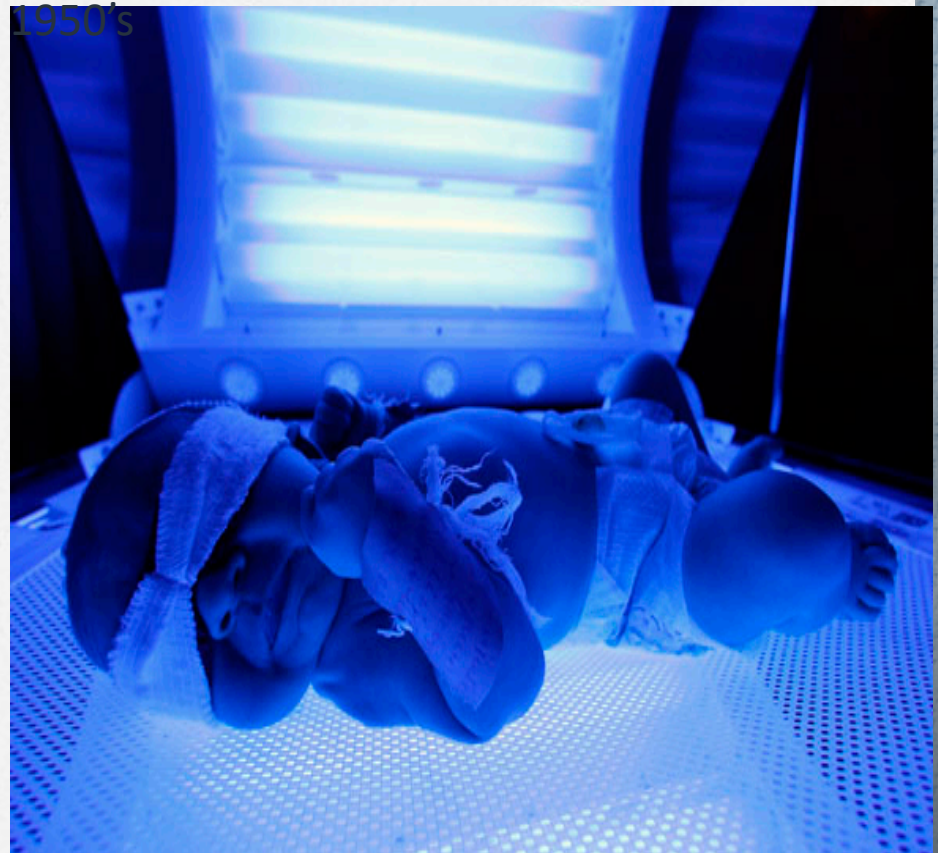

It takes 17 years for research to reach practice.¹

Only 14% of research reaches a patient.¹

Only 18% of administrators and practitioners report using evidence-based practices frequently.²

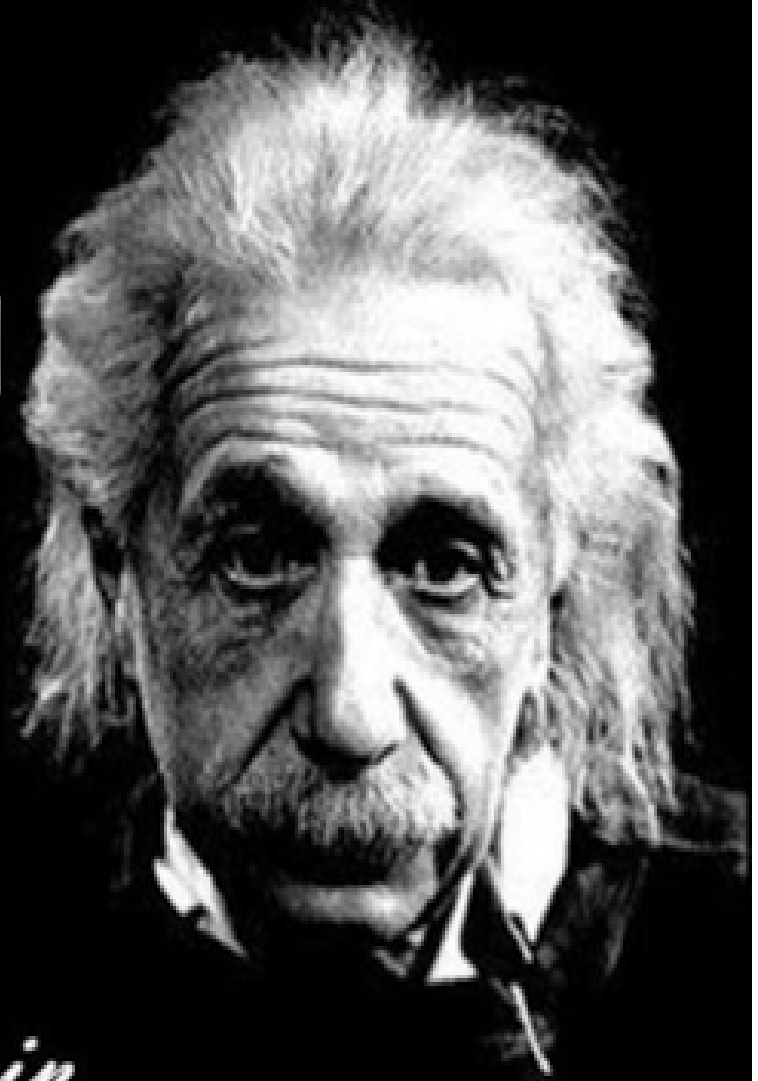

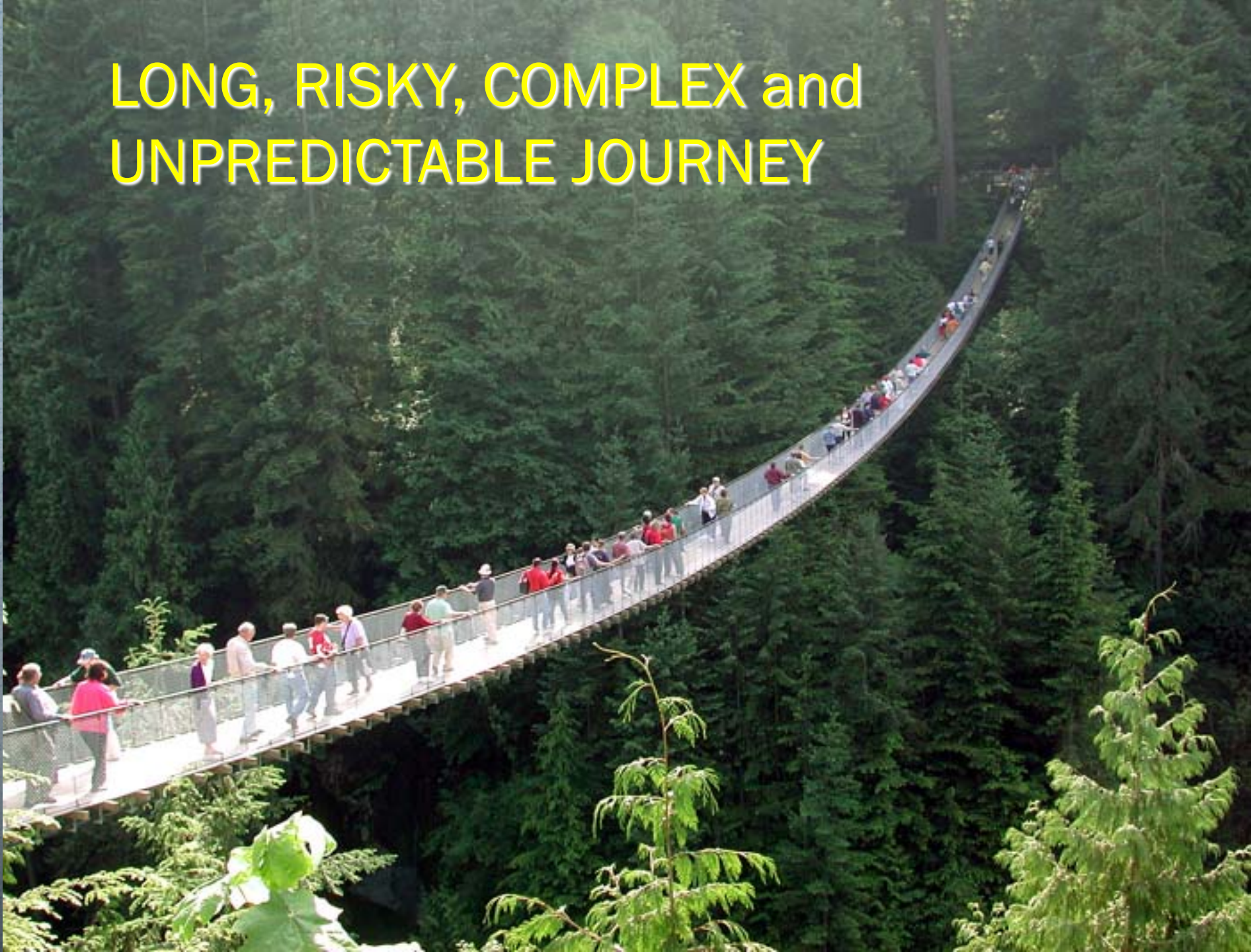
